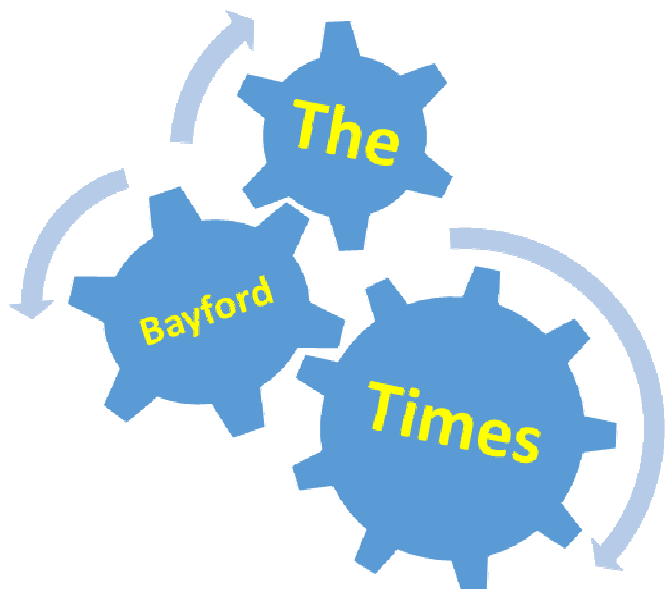

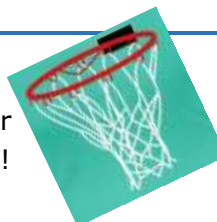
## Sporting Success! Netball

We hope you have a fantastic time!



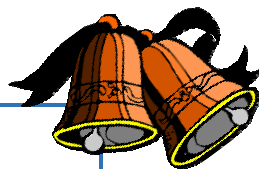
## Class 3 to Bayfordbury Observatory
